Dearest Friends,

This has been an incredible year of ministry opportunities because of your prayers and giving. We are so grateful. We want to thank you and ask that you help us continue the work which brings the Good News of the Gospel and gives a hand-up to those in desperate need.

The earthquake in Haiti on January 12, 2010 led EMI to make three working trips to this devastated country, making a difference in countless lives. Over a thousand water filters were distributed through hundreds of evangelism equipped church members to meet the immediate need of clean water and Living Water to their friends, neighbors and relatives. EMI saw the impending health disaster before the epidemic of cholera hit the news building seven latrines in one tent-city where over 50,000 people were living without any sanitary facilities. In addition, a water well was drilled to help with the ongoing demand for clean water. Looking ahead to meet the upcoming need to rebuild, a vocational construction training facility is being established, helping train and equip those affected with skills to rebuild and have ongoing businesses.

The needs of Haiti did not stop EMI from continuing and expanding its work in 2010 in the terrorist-ridden areas of Southern Sudan, DR Congo, and Northern Uganda. Don is currently in Africa. This is his second trip this year, teaching and training through the local churches in the hardest to reach areas. Don was praising God when he called early in December to tell how there are now over 20 tons of seeds to be harvested from the initial seeds and tools that were taken in and cultivated earlier this year. These seeds can now be distributed in new areas of DR Congo. Local farmers have a commodity to sell and EMI can continue to help more people help themselves.
