

To Provide Life-Saving Seeds & Tools for the persecuted

After success in September 2009 helping those in Ezo, South Sudan, EMI is burdened to reach into another of the desperate areas where they are currently working to build the second Community Christian Radio Station and helping those who have been displaced by the LRA terrorists.

LRA Bring Terror

The Lord's Resistance Army (LRA) led by Joseph Kony terrorized Northern Uganda for more than 20 years killing tens of thousands, forcing some 2,000,000 to flee their homes and kidnapping approximately 66,000 children, boys and girls for soldiers and girls as sex slaves.

By 2006, the LRA had moved from Northern Uganda to South Sudan, Central African Republic, and DR Congo, the very area where EMI is working. The LRA continue these atrocities today.

This is very much a spiritual battle. The primary targets have been the Christian Church and its women and children. Since Christmas Eve 2008 in excess of 2,000 people have been killed, over 1,000 have been brutally murdered, some burned alive inside the 30 churches attacked while over 2,500 children were kidnapped, much of this during Christmas worship services. Some of our friends have literally been nailed to trees and tortured to death. Over 250,000 people have now fled their homes for the safety of makeshift refugee camps, many with nothing but the clothes on their backs.

Aid is Scarce

The camps are remote and scattered. Very little aid is reaching these camps. These Congolese brothers and sisters are hard working subsistence farmers who eat what they grow. *If they do not plant, they do not eat.*

The necessary work for Spring planting begins soon when the brush is cut and burnt in preparation for planting in March and April. This is the primary planting season and if it is missed there will likely be widespread starvation. These


This ARROW BOY holds his baby daughter, ready to protect her with the only weapon he has, his bow and arrows.
