

## Radio Station

We have been working in Southern Sudan since November 2000, when eight bombs were dropped on the church where we were teaching on Sunday morning at 9 A.M. God has allowed us to train and equip thousands to effectively share their faith in Christ and train others to do the same. Now God is opening the doors for the Gospel to be spread even further in this very remote part of Africa.

We have a complete radio station, with the tower, transmitters, solar and wind generators for power, and a thousand fixed-station radios in a container waiting for us in Uganda. We will be transporting these over the rutted, dirt road that is the main highway into Southern Sudan. The land is ready and waiting for the arrival of this equipment. The people are ready and waiting for the arrival of this equipment. This will be the first radio station in this area where over two million people live. This station will carry the Good News over an area that broadcasts into three countries. They are Southern Sudan, D. R. Congo, and Central African Republic (C.A.R.). Pray for the many lives that may be hearing about the Good News of Jesus Christ for the first time, because of your help.

We also have a portable sawmill in the container, which will also be transported along with the radio station. This sawmill allows us to use the local timber to be make the roof trusses for the new radio station building, as well as doors, windows, tables, desks, and chairs for the schools, churches, and training centers already built in two towns. This can all be done by the members of the growing, local church. They have always had wood, but no way to effectively use it. Now your help will open another door of opportunity for them. Yes, even make the doors!

We have a picture in our minds of many members of a village sitting together listening to the Good News being broadcast over the airwaves in a thousand different locations. Just imagine, this will be the first time most of these people will be hearing a radio. Presently the villages communicate by beating drums to share and pass on information. Now the best news of all can be heard and received into the hearts of young and old alike.
